"MYTHOLOGIES" - A Photographic Choreography"

The Photography Exhibition entitled "MYTHOLOGY" - A Photographic Choreography, by director-photographer Spyros Domazakis, curated by Art Historian, Anna Chassanakou, will be inaugurated on Saturday, June 24, 2023 at 7:00 p.m., at the Archaeological Museum of Ancient Corinth, under the auspices of the Ephorate of Antiquities of Corinth.

As the curator of the exhibition states:

"The exhibition narrative is articulated in 15 scenes - "mythologies", through 22 photographic works - images of dancers who represent ancient Greek myths and paintings on vessels, having as background the archaeological sites of Ancient Corinth and Ancient Nemea.

The Photographer sees in Greek mythology, an inexhaustible source of images and subjects and attempts, through his own visual language, an interpretative approach to the universal and timeless issues it raises. The starting point and guide in his work are the monuments themselves, which become the protagonists, but also the "eternal" setting where the action unfolds.

The reference to the "mythical" figures of Nelly's, the first Greek photographer to photograph a dancer on the Acropolis, but also of Isidore Duncan, "mother of modern dance", is evident in his work.

Thus, next to the small Aryballos of Pyrvias' dance coming alive, stands, among a world of Gods and Heroes, the figure of Isidore Duncan, completing a puzzle of symbols and references that travels through the centuries, passes through the photographer's gaze, and transforms into a new fiction".

The exhibition will be opened by the Head of the Ephorate of Antiquities of Corinth, Mrs. Panagiota Kasimi.

In the frame of the exhibition opening, a dance performance inspired by ancient Greek forms will be presented.
